Paoli PA – Oktoberfest Main Line is a family-friendly take on the Oktoberfest tradition. Kids can enjoy a free kindergarten play area with games, pumpkin decorating, face painting, and bouncy-houses. Kids-at-heart have live entertainment, food, and of course what would Oktoberfest be without a selection of great beers.

Hosted by Rotary Club of the Upper Main Line, 100% of the proceeds support humanitarian work in the local Main Line region and around the world in partnership with Rotary International.

Now in its seventh year, this annual Oktoberfest brings together hundreds of families to enjoy games, entertainment, and food. The event is rain-or-shine – a huge festival tent ensures that if there's a little rain, it won't dampen the fun. The food includes premium kielbasa and what insiders say is the best German potato salad you can get outside of Munich. There's a selection of beers including local craft seasonals, plus root beer. The entertainment includes German oompah bands, dancers, singers, and a variety of audience participation events. The grand finale is a traditional stein-holding strength contest.

"Everyone has a blast! Kids love the kindergarten play area. They jump around in the bouncy houses, get their faces painted, do crafts like pumpkin-painting, and play all kinds of games where they can win prizes," says Lauren Adamski, the Oktoberfest's lead organizer. "Parents love that it's an enclosed zone where the activities are supervised, and there's no extra charge. We don't nickel-and-dime people for the activities. Kids get in free and they can play as much as they want. Parents can relax, listen to music, and enjoy a beer. What could be better?"

Tickets are \$10 at the door or \$8 in advance from the website. Guests under 21 years old enter free in the care of a paying adult.
